Greenwoods Corner Safety Improvements

With the support of the Albert – Eden Local Board and due to high pedestrian demand we are improving pedestrian safety at Greenwoods Corner in Epsom.

We'll try to start the work on time but factors outside our control, such as weather could mean a delayed timeline. If the delay is significant, we'll notify you.

Where	Intersection of Pah Road and Manukau Road in Epsom
When	31 March to early May 2025
Work Hours	The majority of work will be carried out during the night to lessen the impact on businesses. Night Works: Sunday to Thursday 9pm to 5am Day Works: 10am to 4pm
What	To make it safer for everyone we are: <ul style="list-style-type: none">– Installing a new pedestrian crossing across Manukau Road (northern side).– Reshaping the existing two stage crossing to a standard pedestrian crossing.– Reconstructing the median traffic island on Manukau Road.– Associated footpath, driveway, road marking and signage works. Local Impact	We will minimise disruption as much as we can during the works period and encourage you to stay connected with our construction team. We understand night construction work can be a bit loud and disruptive; we will do our best to keep noise levels down. Temporary vehicle access to your property will be maintained, however this access won't be available on the day of concrete pours and while the concrete cures. Our contractors will contact you directly 24 hours prior to concrete pours if this impacts your property.
Traffic Impact	Traffic management will be in place to allow construction crews to work safely. A temporary speed limit of 30km/hr and stop / go traffic management will be in place. We need to close a sections of footpath where we are working and detour pedestrians around the worksite. During attended work hours, Traffic Controllers will be on site to guide and assist residents, vehicles and pedestrians. During unattended hours pedestrian traffic management will remain in place.
